

Conditions for granting additional credit:

- Students who did not meet only point 2 of the requirements (earning at least 60% on the midterm tests) in the winter semester to receive regular credit in medicinal chemistry and biochemistry must take the credit test.
- The test consists of **25 test questions including numerical examples and formulas** (see List of structures). Each question answered completely correctly is worth 1 point.
- **The test will cover the material covered in the seminars, practical exercises and lectures in biochemistry during the winter semester.**
- Each student **MUST** present a **transcript or student ID card** to the advisor before taking the test. Students without ID will not be allowed to enter the lecture hall where the test will be written.
- **Each student is entitled to one regular and two make-up attempts within the announced terms.** No additional dates will be announced. The student will register for the announced dates in SIS.
- Students must have their protocols checked by the regular deadline before they can register for the credit test.
- **Withdrawal during the test or refusal to take the test will count as a failed attempt.**
- The result of the credit test will be published in SIS. Consultation on the result of a given test will be given to the student only once, no later than the end of the semester in question. The student must arrange the date of the consultation with the responsible staff member in advance (Mgr. Jan Ševčík, Ph.D., jsevc@lf1.cuni.cz)
