Rules of examinations in Medicinal Chemistry and Biochemistry (B83120) at the Department of Biochemistry and Experimental Oncology in the summer semester 2023/2024

The exam dates (including holiday dates) will be published in SIS on 27 March and the date and time when the dates will be open for registration will also be specified.

The number of terms is finite and unchangeable and exceeds 170% of the number of students in line with the faculty rules of the 1st Faculty of Medicine of Charles University.

A student can take the exam only if he/she has fulfilled all (pre)requisites and is registered for the exam date in SIS.

The examination consists of an entrance test and an oral examination.

The written test contains 7 questions and takes 30 minutes to complete. The test takes place in rogo.cz on the date and time published as the exam date. The login password will be sent to students after the deadline in SIS. The content of the test is chemical calculations (concentration of solutions, mass fraction, pH, preparation and dilution of solutions) and formulas (within the scope of the list of formulas for the exam in medicinal chemistry and biochemistry published on the Institute's website). Each question answered completely correctly is awarded one point. Students who score at least 4 points in the written test will be admitted to the oral examination. This requirement does not apply to the 2nd remedial term, in which the student advances to the oral examination regardless of the number of points obtained in the test. The test results and the roster of students for the oral portion of the exam will be posted on the Institute's website on the afternoon of the written exam. Consultation on the results of a given test is given to a student only once. The student must arrange the consultation date in advance with the responsible staff member (Mgr. Jan Ševčík, Ph.D.).

Oral examinations will always be held on Tuesday-Friday after the written test (unless otherwise stated in the SIS).

In the oral part of the exam, students will draw four questions, one from each section of the list of questions. Students who pass the test and fail the oral part of the exam will not take the test on subsequent make-up dates. For the oral part, students will also submit properly maintained practical logs .

The question outlines and the list of formulae for which knowledge is required and recommended reading are published on the Institute's website.

The tests will take place at the Institute of Biochemistry and Experimental Oncology, U Nemocnice 5, 2nd floor.

The examinations are governed by the Faculty Rules of the 1st Faculty of Medicine of Charles University for the organisation of studies and the Study and Examination Regulations of Charles University.

A student who fails to appear for the examination and does not make a proper excuse in advance is not classified, but the examination term is forfeited. After the forfeiture of the exam date, the student may register for the next exam date.

Only written excuses for medical reasons, duly supported by a medical certificate, will be accepted. A student has the right to take the examination a maximum of three times (three terms). However, if a student does not use the available terms within the announced dates, this does not entitle the student to a special examination date.
