Examination Process for Pathobiochemistry 2- Molecular Oncology (Winter Semester 2024/2025)

All exam dates for Pathobiochemistry 2 - Molecular Oncology (B02432) were announced in the SIS. The number of terms is final, and in accordance with the faculty rules, more than 170% of the terms have been announced. Both, pre-terms and regular terms will be open for registration starting 18th of November 2024; the time will be stated in the SIS.

Examinations will take place at the Institute of Biochemistry and Experimental Oncology, 2nd floor, U Nemocnice 5.

The exam is oral, and the questions are published on the Institute's website. The student can take the exam only if all examination prerequisites are met and if he / she is enrolled for the term in the SIS.

A student who will not attend their scheduled exam and fails to provide an apology (a written explanation and justification) will not be graded; however, the exam term will be forfeited. After forfeiting the term, the student may register for the next available exam date.

The student has the right to attempt the exam up to three times, i.e. has the right for two retake attempts, No additional retake opportunities are allowed. If a student does not use these attempts within the scheduled examination terms, they are not entitled to request a special exam term. No further exam terms will be added.
